As much as I would like to say the Reunion was a great financial success, I must admit it was not; and I must take the blame for that.

The cups did not sell as well as I had hoped, so we lost money on that bit. Also did not sell as many Reunion Cook Books as I would have liked.

We started with \$1031.29 in the Reunion Account. I had 75 Cook books printed at a cost of \$476.25* and the 40 cups purchased cost \$317.83*. Also donated \$200 to the venue for the use of their fellowship hall leaving us with \$37.21. The sale of cups, books, auction and donations netted us \$587.00 leaving us with \$624.21. We have 13 Cups and 38 Books remaining.

Certainly, if anyone would like to purchase extras we can make that happen in an effort to reduce the shortfall.
